1.0 BACKGROUND

1.1 Introduction

The Directorate of Police Health Services (PHS) started as Police Medical Services (PMS) unit in 1963 with only a maternity ward at Nsambya Police Barracks to cater for the Policewomen at the time.

In 1970, clinical services (outpatient department) were established at Naguru Police College (the current FFU base) to cater for the health needs of Police officers and their families. At that time the unit was run by only three nurses (1 Senior Nursing Officer and 2 Enrolled Nurses) who were later joined by one (1) Medical Doctor and two (2) other senior nurses.

In 1975, the clinical services were extended to Nsambya Police Barracks and since then, it is the headquarters of Police Health Services (PHS). From that period, the Directorate has extended these services to different districts across the country. With the recruitment of more medical doctors in 2001, medico-legal services became a core function of the department to support the criminal investigations to adduce scientific evidence before courts of law through postmortem examination and examination of victims and suspects of crime.

In support of Police operations, the scope of services scaled up to include Emergency Medical Response Services to evacuate casualties in Uganda.

1.2 Mandate, Vision, Mission, Goal and Objectives

1.2.1 Mandate

The Directorate of Police Health Services (PHS) is mandated to treat, prevent and control the occurrence of communicable and non-communicable diseases as well as promote good health lifestyles and behavior in the Police and surrounding community. The Directorate further extends its services to the general population through Medical Emergency Response and provision of Medico-legal services.

1.2.2 Vision

A healthy and productive Uganda Police Force that contributes to national development.

1.2.3 Mission

To provide health services to the Uganda Police Force to the maximum possible standards that are evidence based and are in line with the Ministry of Health guidelines.

1.2.4 Goal

To deliver outstanding health services for a healthy and productive Police Force.

1.2.5 Specific objectives

The Directorate specifically addressed the following objectives:

- To strengthen the organization and management of the Police health system.
- To provide medico legal services in support of the criminal investigations.
- To provide universal health coverage to the UPF and surrounding community.
- To support the national emergency medical response and rescue services.
- To promote health research agenda in UPF.
- To mobilize resources for Police health service delivery.
- To establish partnerships in Police health service delivery.
- To promote supervision, monitoring, evaluation and accountability of Police health programs.

2.0 MANAGEMENT AND ORGANIZATION OF POLICE HEALTH SERVICES

The Directorate of PHS is organized at three management levels; i.e. headquarters, region and district level.

(i) At PHS headquarters

The Directorate is headed by Director and deputized by Deputy Director Police health services. There are four (04) departments (i.e. Clinical, Public health, Medco-legal and Administration & Training) meant to be headed by Commissioners of Police but currently headed by officers in acting capacity. It is at this level that policy, strategic and oversight functions are performed. The Health Management Committee (HMC) whose composition is as shown in table 1 below takes center stage in policy and strategic guidance on matters of health.

(i) At the region

The Regional Police surgeons who are directly supervised by the Regional Police commanders head the health services. Only nine (32%) regions have Police surgeons creating a management gap in other regions. The regions with Police surgeons include, Elgon, Aswa, East Kyoga, West Nile, Albertine, Rwenzori West, Wamala, KMP North and KMP South. (iii) At the District

At this level, UPF has health centers where direct implementation of health services occurs. Temporally or mobile clinics are also established as and when need arises. Police Health centers are headed by in-charges who are supervised by the respective Regional Police Surgeons and District Police Commanders.

The health centers are managed with support of the Health Unit Management Committees (HUMC) which are chaired by DPCs. There are 93 Police health facilities distributed in 76 districts/

divisions and of these, 89(95%) have managers of appropriate medical cadre (at least Diploma in clinical medicine, Diploma in Nursing and Certificate in Nursing).

2.1 Management Committees

2.1.1 Health Management Committee (HMC)

This is the top governing body of the Directorate of Police Health Services. It is chaired by the Director Police health services and has sixteen (16) members drawn from different departments/ units as reflected in table 1 above. It is mandated to provide strategic guidance to the directorate and to advise Police management on all health matters affecting the UPF. This committee holds monthly meetings, however, in the reporting year, only 10 (83%) meetings were held.

2.1.2 Health Unit Management Committee (HUMC)

The HUMC are health facility committees which are chaired by the DPC/unit commander. The committee supervises the day-to-day activities in the facilities. The HUMC are meant to hold monthly meetings and forward the recommendations/resolutions to headquarters for implementation.

2.1.3 Annual General Meeting (AGM)

The Directorate of Police Health Services held the AGM on 24th September 2021, at Police Headquarters-Naguru. The meeting was presided over by the IGP Okoth J.M. Ochola (Esq). The meeting was also attended by Chief

of Joint Staff, AIGP Jack Bakasumba and other 70 participants drawn from among the members of the Health Management committee, Regional Police surgeons, and representatives from Police health centers across the country.

The 2021 AGM theme; Improving and standardizing health service delivery in UPF through strengthening human resource.

The objectives of the 2021 AGM were;

- To promote a culture of all-inclusive planning process for health services in UPF.
- To Share experiences, achievements and challenges during health service delivery; and
- To collectively propose strategies to improve health services and develop the directorate of PHS.

The meeting discussed a lot of issues and made the following recommendations:

1. To provide motorcycle transport for all Police health centers.
2. To expand ICT infrastructure to support data management for health services
3. To subject all medical personnel caught stealing government drugs to the disciplinary court.
4. To procure more ambulances to cover the whole country
5. To recruit more Police health workers
6. To construct a Police Hospital.
7. To renovate at least 06 Police health centers in the next calendar year.

8. Regional surgeons to routinely profile sick and undeployable Police personnel for management action.
9. To equip 08 health centers, each with a drug storage cupboard, 2 office chairs and 2 patient waiting benches.
10. Establish more Police health centers at district level.
11. To co-opt two (02) regional surgeons on the HMC.
12. To repair the solar system for Mbale Police maternity unit.

3.0 SERVICES OFFERED

The Directorate offers integrated health care services, which include but not limited to; preventive, curative, palliative, medico-legal and emergency medical response services. These services are offered at the 93 static Police health centers and through medical outreaches/mobile clinics to the Police community and the general public. The Police HCs are spread across the country and are at different levels of care. I.e. HC II (79), HC III (10) and HC IV (04) as shown in appendix 1.

The services are mainly outpatient care, except for the six (06) maternity centers at, Nsambya, Masaka, Jinja, Mbale, Tororo and Arua. Police is still inadequately equipped to offer patient admissions, major surgeries and radiology services due to limited health infrastructure and human resource capacity. Below is a brief account of the health services offered in the directorate.

3.1 Clinical services



Clinical services include, laboratory diagnostics, treatment and Maternal child health care services (MCH). Other services offered are, dental care at Nsambya, PTS Kabalye and Naguru Police HC IVs while, Eye care at Nsambya Police HC IV. Furthermore, the

directorate provides HIV prevention, treatment, care and support services at the 13 accredited Anti-Retroviral Therapy (ART) centers of Nsambya, Naguru, Jinja, Mbale, Tororo, ASTU Katakwi, Gulu, Arua, Hoima, Kabarole, Mbarara, Rukungiri and Masaka.

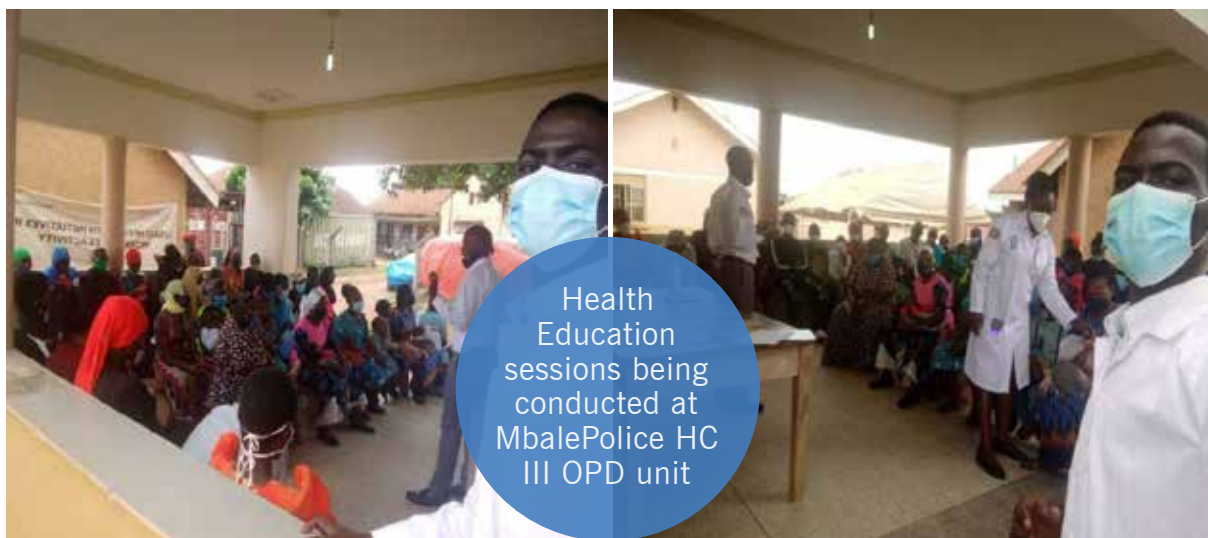
3.2 Public health services

The public health services are carried out to prevent and control communicable and non-communicable diseases. These services include but not limited to;

- Sanitation and hygiene promotion. This is done through community mobilization,

sensitization, vector control services and health inspection of Police establishments.

- Health education and promotion. This is aimed at empowering the Police community to prevent and control diseases as well as promoting good health lifestyles and behavior.



- Disease surveillance. Done to monitor disease trends among Police population to obtain adequate information to guide appropriate health interventions.

3.3 Medico-legal services

The Directorate offers Medico-legal services to support the criminal investigations in the country. This majorly includes;

1. Forensic Pathology; which involves carrying out autopsies on cases of homicide, suicide and accidents among others.

2. Forensic surgery; which involves examination of victims and suspects of crime such as rape, defilement, assault, fire arm injuries, accidents, aggravated robbery, terrorism to mention but a few.

3. Attending court sessions to give evidence as expert witnesses.

4. Conducting Medico-legal trainings to health workers, police officers and the general public.

3.4 Emergency Medical Response Services (EMRS)



Emergency medical response services are primarily done to support Police operations as well as the national medical and public health emergency response services. The Directorate operates an ambulance service system coordinated under the Police Emergency Response Centers across the country. Some of the activities undertaken by the EMRS include;

1. Provision of medical cover to convoys of national and international dignitaries, national functions and special operations.

2. Evacuation of casualties involved in accidents and natural or human induced catastrophes to nearby health facilities.
3. Provision of ambulance services to Police personnel, their immediate family members and the general community.



4.0 RESOURCES FOR POLICE HEALTH SERVICES

4.1 Human Resource

The current staff strength in the Directorate of Police Health services stands at 505 personnel. These include technical health workers & support staff of different Police ranks and professional diversity (as shown in appendix 2). In the reporting year, there was an internal advert by UPF for Police officers with medical qualifications. One hundred ninety two

applicants qualified and the regrading process is ongoing.

In the year 2021, one (01) health worker retired from active service while another deserted from the Force. The active number of staff was further affected in various ways such as mission deployments and staff on training (study leave) as seen in the table 3 below.

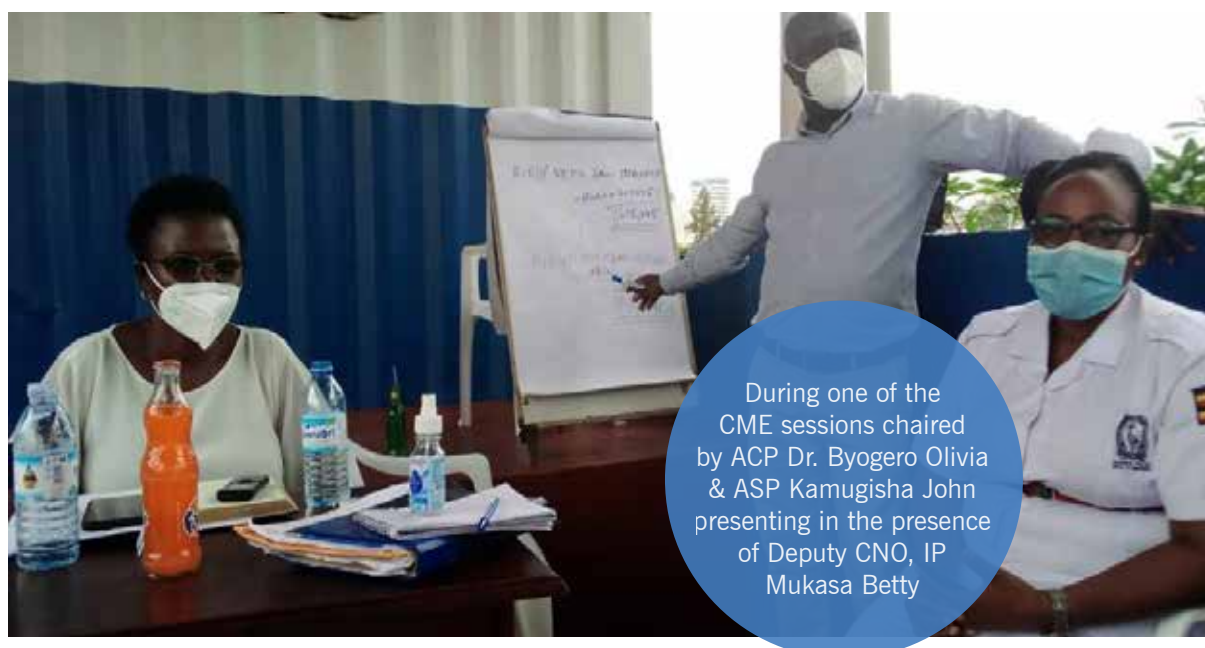

4.1.6 Staff training

- Staff for further studies in public institutions:** Within the past one year, thirty two (32) health workers enrolled for further studies in various medical fields, including, 08 for Bachelor of medicine & Surgery, 06 other degrees, 16 Diplomas and 02 Certificates as reflected in appendix 3. On a positive note UPF was able to sponsor nine (09) students on various programs.
- Officers Basic Course (OBC):** Twenty nine (29) health workers were enrolled for OBC at Kabalye Police Training School as reflected in appendix 4.
- Continuous Medical Education (CME):** Due to the COVID-19 pandemic only two (02) CMEs were conducted at Nsambya Police HC IV on salaries, uniforms and nutrition assessment. These were attended by seventy (70) health workers from KMP.

4.2 Medicines and health supplies



UPF procures medicines and health supplies from different sources i.e through government medical supply system (National Medical Stores - NMS), development partners, and direct procurement by UPF. National Medical Stores delivers supplies directly to the respective Police health facilities basing on routine supply cycles. The essential medicines are supplied according to the level of the facility as per the standard health care package. It is incumbent upon the respective Police health centers to receive the medicines, appropriately store them, ensure rational use, account and keep up-to-date records at every stage of transaction.

Inadequacies of appropriate storage facilities and personnel have persistently been a major challenge to the management of medicines and health supplies in UPF.

Underfunding for procurement of essential medicines and health supplies that are not supplied by NMS is another challenge. The demand for more supplies is usually due to emergency Police operations, emergency medical cover during national functions, medical support to Formed Police Units (FPU) on the African Mission in Somalia (AMISOM) and other training activities at Police training schools.

4.3 Infrastructure



Health infrastructure means and includes; buildings, equipment, transport, waste disposal facilities and ICT.

4.3.1 Buildings: Majority of Police health facilities are housed in very old and small buildings which were not originally designed to serve as health centers. Some are also accommodated in uniports.

4.3.2 Equipment: Most Police health centers have basic diagnostic equipment. However, HC IVs & IIIs still lack important services such as admissions, surgical operations and radiology due to lack of hospital beds, surgical equipment and complete radiology equipment.

4.3.3 ICT infrastructure: This comprises of computers, printers, internet connectivity and

servers. This is critical in timely data collection, analysis and reporting. Currently only 13 Police health centers (ART centers) are equipped with electronic Health Management Information system (HMIS) to support web based ordering of drugs, performance monitoring and reporting. The remaining HCs are supported through respective district reporting system. Even the thirteen (13) equipped health centers also have challenge of unreliable power supply, unskilled personnel, lack of working space and internet connectivity.

4.3.4 Medical waste disposal facilities: Medical wastes generated in health facilities are largely infectious. They must be disposed of in a standard manner to ensure an infection free environment. The health facilities have been disposing off the waste with the district hospitals

medical waste disposal trucks, incinerators at facilities and placenta pits. Some facilities have had trouble disposing medical waste due to lack of waste disposal facilities plus long distances from government health but plans have been made to construct some more incinerators and placenta pits in Police health facilities

4.3.5 Transport: Transport to facilitate health services in UPF is comprised of a fleet of vehicles (ambulances and administrative) and motorcycles. By the end of the reporting period, sound administrative motor vehicles were twelve (12). One (01) administrative motor vehicle was grounded as indicated in table 7 below.

Seventy (70) motorcycles facilitated the mobility of health workers in the year 2021 as indicated in table 8 below.

In the year 2021, Uganda Police Force had 29 ambulances but 26 were functional. Ambulances are used to support emergency medical and public health response services in the country. These were located in various parts of the country as indicated in table 9 below.

Ideally, every department under the Directorate of Police Health Services and the Police surgeons require a vehicle to facilitate supervisory functions and medico-legal services while at least a motorcycle is needed at every Police health center.

5.0 PARTNERSHIPS

The Directorate worked with different partners in the delivery of health services to the target population. The partners included the following;

- 1. Ministry of Health:** Provided overall technical support through mentorships of personnel in DHIS2 reporting, donated nutrition assessment equipment and trained personnel in maternal infant and adolescent nutrition in Nsambya and Naguru, COVID-19 prevention, management and vaccination. It also co-opted the Directorate on the different National Task Forces e.g COVID-19 Task Force and Election Task Force. MOH through Central Public Health Laboratories (CPHL) supported the Directorate with servicing of CBC and Genexpert machines and provision of Covid-19 rapid testing kits.
- 2. National Medical Stores:** Delivered medicines and other health supplies to all Police health centers.
- 3. Uganda AIDS Commission:** Provided technical guidance in HIV and AIDS response.
- 4. JLOS:** Supported equitable access to Medico-legal services by paying health workers for Postmortems UGX. 50,000/= and Examination SGBV victims UGX. 25,000/=.
- 5. Iran-Uganda Hospital:** Offered emergency health services to Police personnel and their immediate families at times on credit.
- 6. Platinum Credit-Uganda Ltd:** Supported the renovation of the Nsambya Police Medical Laboratory and construction of a waiting shade.
- 7. Infectious Disease Institute (IDI):** Provided technical and logistical support for cervical cancer screening, TB care services and HIV care services to Nsambya and Naguru.
- 8. Uganda Red Cross Society:** Supported Emergency Medical Response services for efficient response to Road Traffic Accidents through training.
- 9. Rakai Health Sciences program:** Supported system strengthening for HIV and AIDS response services at Masaka Police health services.
- 10. Dr. Agarwal's Eye Hospital:** Provided Eye care services to Police personnel at a discount of 10% on all treatment costs below 500,000/= and 15% discount on treatment costs of 500,000/= and above.
- 11. GIZ** started the construction of two hand washing facilities at Nsambya Police health center IV. It also plans to build a block of toilets at the facility in the year 2022.

6.0 PERFORMANCE

6.1 Summary of key performance outputs

All the implemented activities were targeted to achieve the set annual performance outputs for the year 2021 as outlined below;

1. Access to quality and effective health services by police community improved
2. Adequate environmental health and sanitation services to the Police communities provided. Coordination and management of Police Health Services (PHS) strengthened.
3. Effective provision of Emergency Medical Response Services (EMRS) improved
4. Management of maternity neonatal Child health (MNCH) services at 13 Police sites strengthened.
5. Palliative and psychosocial support services to personnel with life limiting health conditions strengthened.
6. Police Health Policy and research in UPF promoted
7. Prevention and control of the spread of COVID-19 and other viral hemorrhagic infections in Police community Strengthened
8. Prevention and control of the spread of HIV and Tuberculosis (TB) at 16 Police health centers strengthened.

9. Response to and management of medico-legal cases by health care providers enhanced.

6.2 General administration, coordination and supervision

6.2.1 Health Management Committee meetings

These are monthly meetings held at the Directorate to monitor and evaluate performance indicators, discuss and review the policy and strategic direction for health services in UPF. Ten (10) Health Management Committee (HMC) meetings were held in the year 2021. This shows an improvement compared to the seven (07) meetings held in the previous year.

6.2.2 Central meeting of all Police Surgeons

The Directorate holds quarterly central meetings of all Police Surgeons upon availability of funds. The meetings form a platform for the central management team to closely interact with the regional supervisors (Surgeons) and review Directorate's performance. Extensively discussed are the achievements, challenges and prioritize the recommendations for improving service delivery. In the reporting period, three (3) meetings were held.

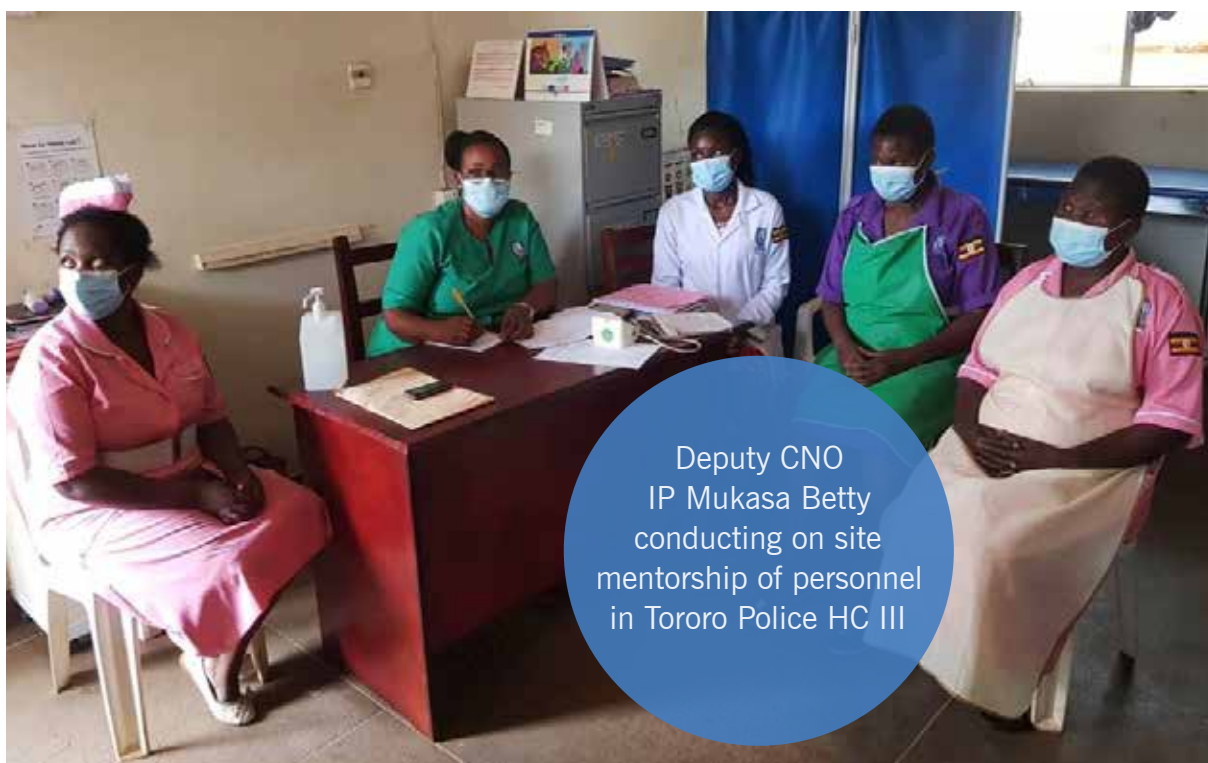
6.2.3 Health Policy and Strategic plan for PHS

In the year 2021, the first Police Health Policy was completed, approved, printed and dissemination started. In the same vein, the Directorate continued with the development of Police Health strategic Plan (PHSP1) 2020/2021 – 2024/2025 and the process was ongoing by the end of the reporting period.

6.2.4 Supervision of Police health centers

Police health centers are supervised at three levels i.e. Monthly supervision at the

district (by District Health Officers – DHOs), quarterly supervision at the region (by Police surgeons), and twice a year at the center (by PHS Directorate) with the aim of quality assurance and improvement through coaching and mentorship. Eighty six (86) Police health centers (92%) were supervised directly by the respective DHOs and these were able to report their monthly performances in the Ministry of Health (MoH) reporting system (District Health Information System - DHIS2). This reflects an improvement compared to the 80 facilities that were reporting through DHIS2 in the previous year.



In the next reporting period, PHS plans to pursue the registration of the remaining 07 Police health centers namely; Ibanda, Elegu, Kaliro, Buyende, Mayuge, PTS Ikafe and PTS Olilim to the MoH reporting system to enhance monitoring and supervision. The regional Police surgeons carried out support supervision of fifty

five (55) Police health centers translating to 59%. This underperformance was attributed to the fact that some regions do not have Police surgeons. It is planned that the existing Police surgeons are supported to extend their services to cover other regions without Police Surgeons.

Centrally, the directorate supervised 46 health facilities (Rukungiri, Kabale, Kisoro, Bushenyi, Ibanda, Isingiro, Kasese, Fortportal, Bundibugyo, Hoima, Masindi, PTS Kabalye, Moroto, Soroti, ASTU Katakwi, Jinja, Kamuli, Kaliro, Kapchorwa, Bukwo, Sironko, Arua, Gulu, Koboko, Tororo, Malaba, Iganga, Bugiri, Masaka, Mbarara, Luwero, Pallisa, Ntungamo, Kibaale, Kyenjojo, Nakasongola, Bombo, Mubende, Mityana, Kiboga, Busunju, Mpigi, Buwama, Kalangala, Kalisizo, Ssembabule).

6.3 Out Patient/ (OPD) attendance

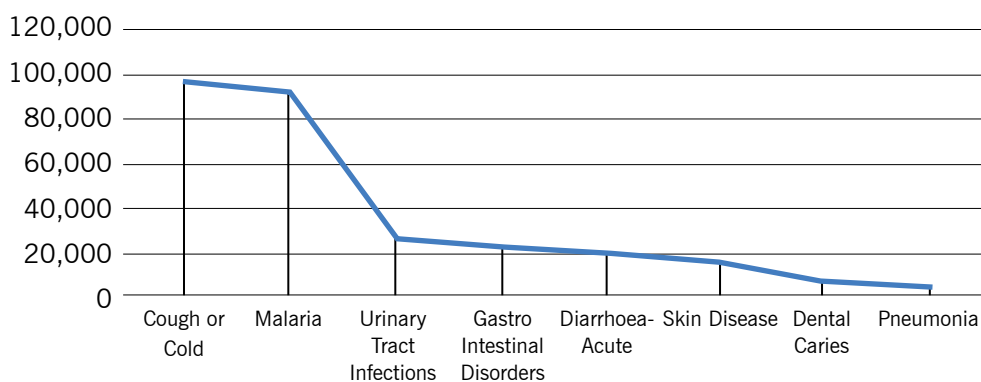
The Directorate offered OPD services at its 93 health centers. A total of 380,190 patients were treated in the year 2021. The complicated cases that could not be handled at Police health centers were referred to other government health facilities. The disease burden as managed at Police health centers is reflected in table 10 below.

It should be noted that fourteen (14) of these health centers were visited two times because of the need for follow-ups.

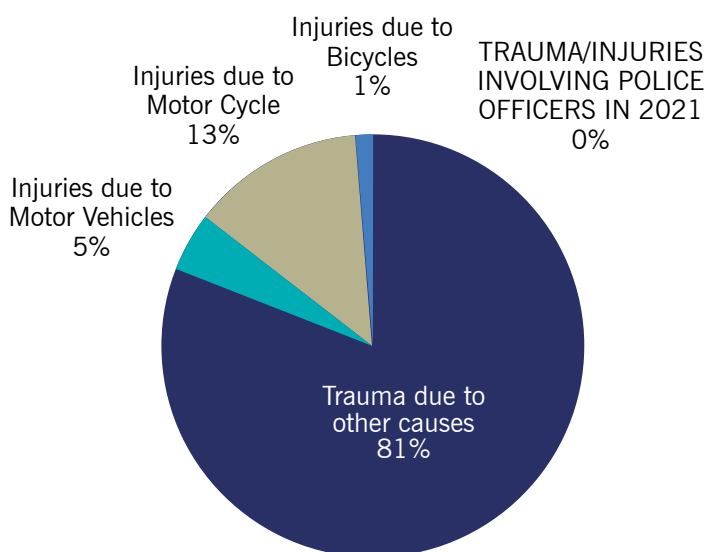

6.4 Maternal and Child Health (MCH) Care



Fourteen (14) Police health centers provided MCH services. The services include antenatal, maternity, postnatal care, immunization and family planning. However, deliveries were conducted at only six (06) maternity centers of Arua,

Nsambya, Jinja, Masaka, Tororo and Mbale. Arua maternity center alone had a total of 757 admissions, 632 deliveries and 94 mothers were referred for better management. The annual performance is showed in table 12 below.

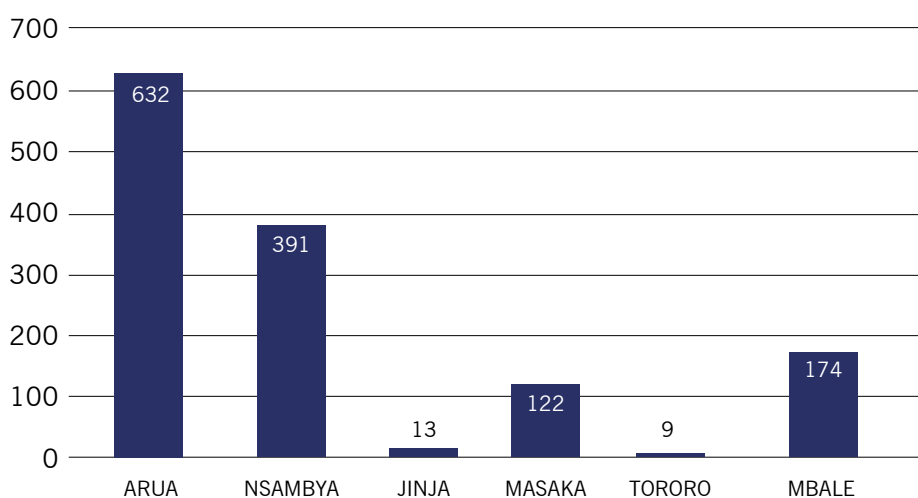

The directorate provided laboratory services at the 28 medical laboratories located at; Nsambya Pol H/C IV, Naguru Pol H/C IV, Marine Unit Kigo Pol H/C II, Bwebajja PTS H/C II, Kikandwa Pol H/C II, Jinja Pol H/C III, Nalufenya Pol H/C II, Iganga Pol H/C II, Mayuge Pol H/C II, Tororo Pol H/C II, Mbale Pol H/C III, Soroti Pol H/C II, ASTU Katakwi Pol H/C IV, Moroto Pol H/C II, Lira Pol H/C II, Gulu Pol H/C III, Arua Pol H/C III, Ikafe Pol H/C II, Masindi Pol H/C II, Kabalye Pol H/C IV, Hoima Pol H/C III, Fort Portal Pol H/C

6.8 HIV and AIDS prevention, care, treatment and support.

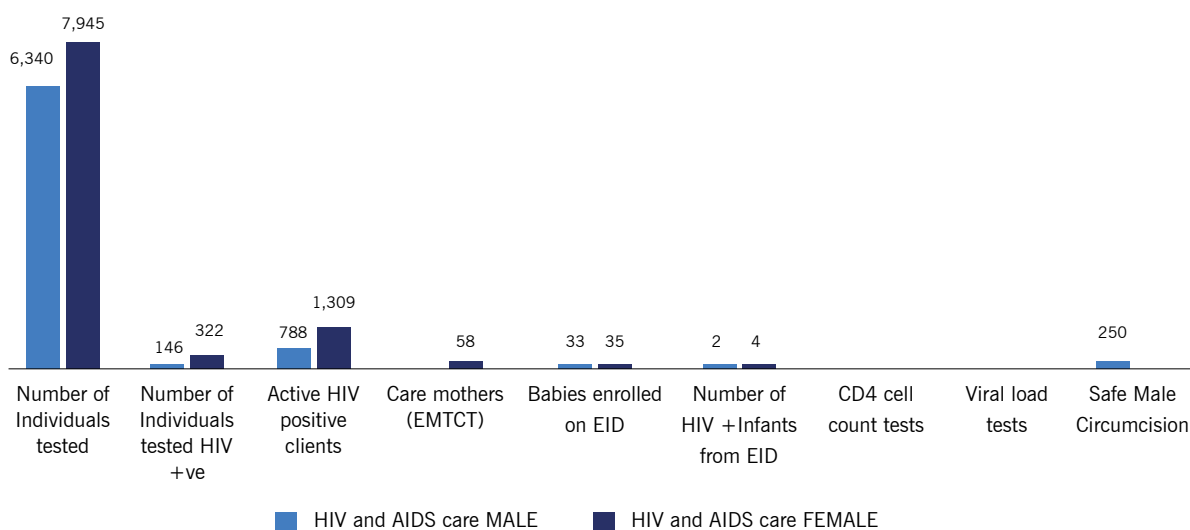

6.9 UPF response to COVID-19 pandemic

1. A ten (10)-bed COVID-19 isolation center at Nsambya was operationalized to cater for officers who are unable to isolate in their homes. In the reporting year, the facility provided Covid-19 treatment to 46 Police personnel where 43 were discharged, 02 escaped and 01 died.
2. Supplied assorted Anti COVID-19 items i.e masks, gloves, sanitizer, and automatic sanitizer dispensers with inbuilt infrared thermometer, coveralls, face shields, body bags, gum boots, disposable medical gowns, pulseoximeters and jik to all Police units countrywide.
3. Supported the national rapid response to COVID-19, with personnel and ambulances throughout the country.
4. Implemented robust disinfection activities in different Police establishments as a response to reported COVID-19 positive cases and as a preventive measure. A total of 127 disinfections were carried out in various Police establishments.
5. Supported Police personnel with effective linkage to COVID-19 testing and treatment centers.
6. Conducted sensitization sessions about COVID-19 in Police establishments.
7. Vaccination commenced on the 20th March 2020 at Police headquarters with Astra Zeneca vaccine. One hundred and thirty six (136) districts within twenty Eight (28) Police regions were visited by UPF vaccination teams for the 1st and 2nd dose. Ministry of Health allocated 33,928 vials of vaccine each containing about 11 -12 doses to UPF. A total of 39,583 people were vaccinated by UPF teams: 23,453 (M:18,774 F: 4,679) received the 1st dose while 16,130 (M: 12,309 F: 3,821) received the 1st and 2nd dose. PTS Kabalye was the most populated single site of vaccination where 5,866 (Male: 4391. Female: 1475) all trainees and staff were fully vaccinated. Therefore sixty nine percent (69%) personnel in UPF were fully vaccinated.



6.10 Palliative care services

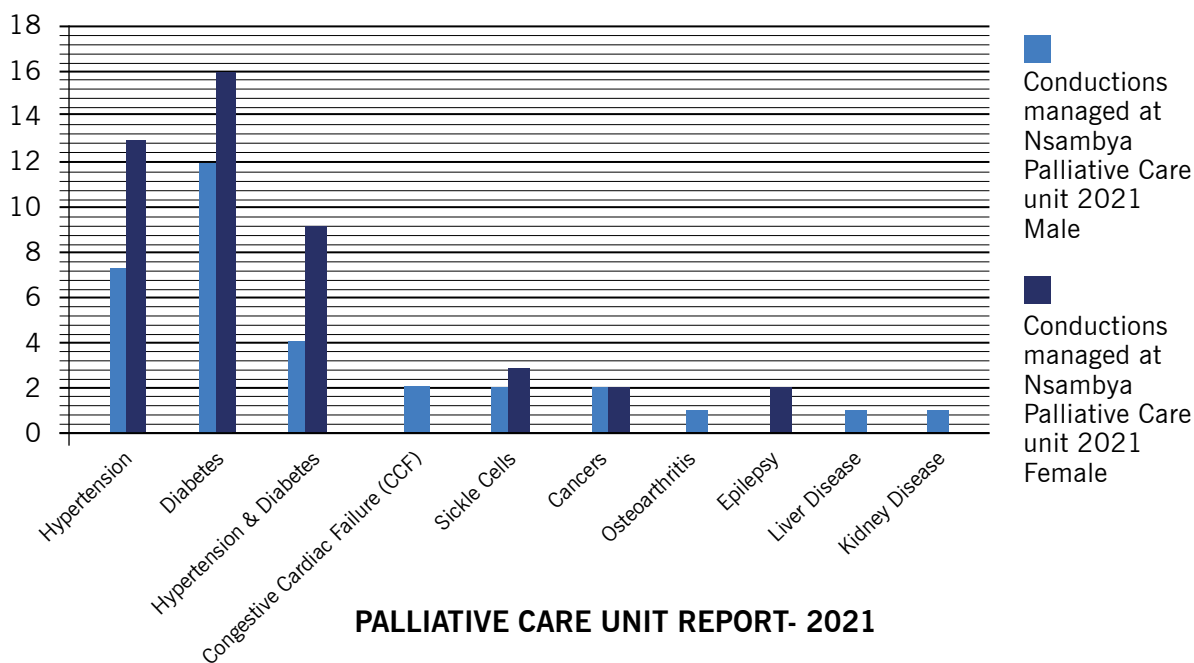
The health care package offered at Nsambya Palliative Clinic included counseling and conservative treatment of chronic illnesses.

6.11 Medico legal services

- 1. Training of Doctors:** A total of twenty nine (29) doctors from; Aswa (10), Elgon (13), Kigezi (04), East Kyoga (01) and Wamala (01) regions were trained in Postmortem examinations and techniques.
- 2. Training of morticians:** Twenty two (22) morticians were trained to support surgeons in maintenance of mortuary hygiene and performance of postmortem examinations. These were drawn from; Kigezi (02), Kampala (11), Albertine (3), AWSA (4), Busoga East (1) and Elgon (01).
- 3. Seventy three (73) health workers** were oriented in Medico legal services in eight (08) regions of Kigezi, Aswa, Albertine, Rwenzori west, East Kyoga, Elgon, West Nile, Wamala.

- 4. Support supervision of Medico-legal services** was conducted in 14 regions (covering 62 districts) i.e. Aswa, West Nile, North West Nile, Kigezi, Busoga East, Kiira, Katonga, Albertine, Rwenzori West, Wamala, Bukedi, Elgon, Sipi and East Kyoga.
- 5. Postmortem examinations:** Three thousand eight hundred fifty seven (3,857) postmortems were performed at Police Mortuary/KCCA mortuary Kampala.
- 6. Sexual and Gender Based Violence (SGBV):** The cases that were seen in Police health facilities were 2899 and of these 1780 were injuries, 52 were anxiety disorders, 15 were abortions and 1052 were sexually transmitted infections.

6.12 Emergency Medical Services



The Directorate supported Police personnel and their immediate family members in various parts of the country with emergency care and also monitored them while hospitalized. The Directorate actively

supported movement of Police patients to hospitals and back home after discharge through the UPF ambulance system. The performance for the reporting period is reflected in table 19 below.

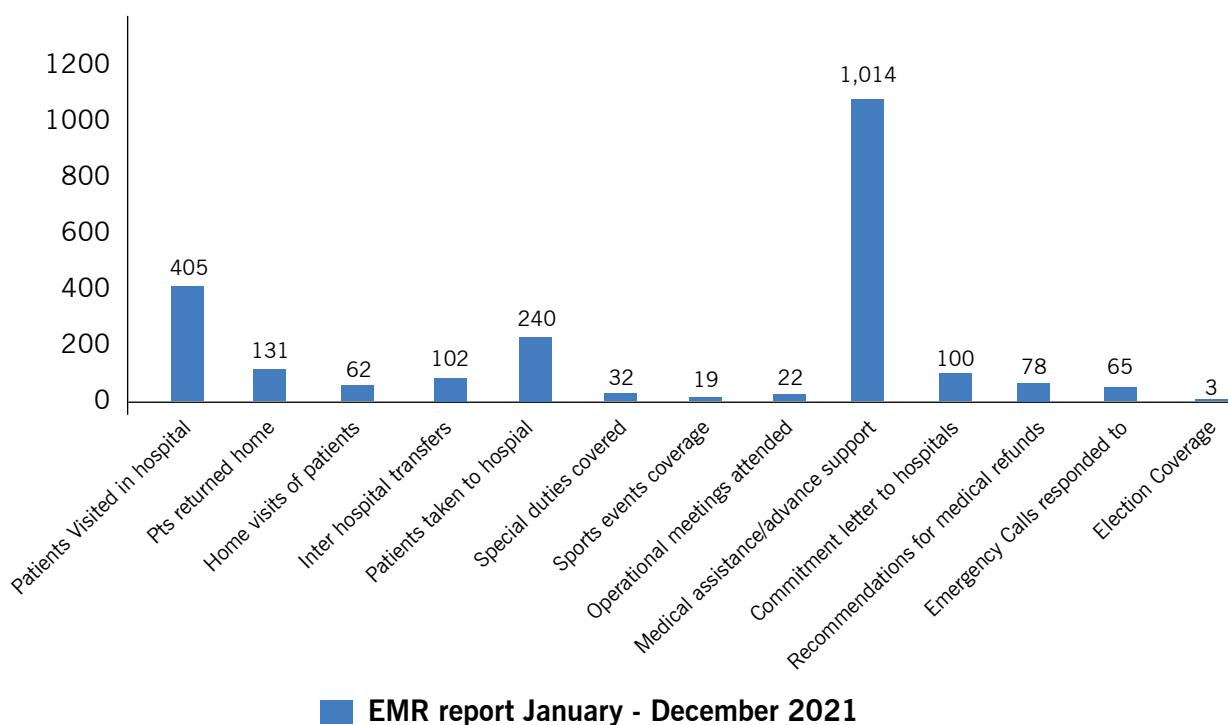

6.13 Public Health Interventions

The interventions here specifically targeted to carry out health inspections of police establishments, control insect vectors and COVID-19 disinfection in the police establishments, mobilize and educate the community on the identified issues of public health importance and also identify, track & report diseases of national importance like Tuberculosis, measles among others.

6.13.1 Disease surveillance: Given the congregate nature of Police establishments,

this intervention was very instrumental in the identification and management of fever, malaria, TB, typhoid, pneumonia, dysentery and measles cases as well as prevention of further spread. Follow up and tracing of TB contacts and ensuring effective management and prevention was done. Performance of the activity in the reporting period is reflected here below in table 20.

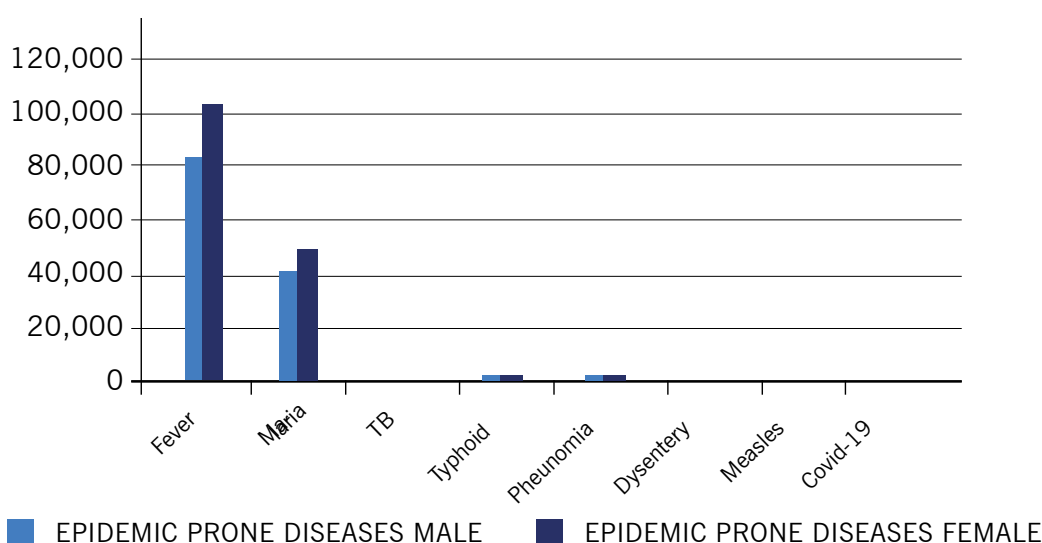

6.13.2 Health Inspection: One hundred twenty (120) health inspections were conducted in the various Police establishments. These were aimed at promoting interventions and prevent diseases that may arise from poor hygiene, use of contaminated water, poor management of domestic waste among others.

6.13.3 Health education: The activity was carried out on daily basis at all Police Health facilities, however a team from Directorate headquarters was able to

carry out Two hundred and ninety eight (298) health education sessions at various police establishments on COVID-19 facts, prevention and control, general sanitation and hygiene improvement, immunization, HIV testing services, SGBV, among others.

6.13.4 Vector control/ Disinfection: In the reporting period, PHS conducted One hundred and twenty seven (127) disinfections against COVID-19 and One hundred and thirty (130) vector control indoor residual spraying sessions in various Police establishments across the country.

6.14 Outreach services:

Two (02) medical camps were organized in Pader and Bundibugyo districts. Bundibugyo had a total of 631 clients (M:183, F:449) and Pader had a total of 1058 clients (M:422, F:636).

The Directorate also partnered with Muyenga Rotary club and offered outreach services in Luuka district with a total of 1002 clients (M: 268, F: 734) The clients received various services including HIV testing, dental care, eye care and outpatient services.

7.0 FINANCIAL REPORT

The Directorate spent a total of UgX. 9,184,071,123/= (non-wage recurrent) on various funding areas as indicated in table 21 below. Specifically, the 1,550,400,823/= which was released to support medicines and sundries of which 1,253,128,573/= was the total value of supplies from National Medical Stores

(NMS) and the 297,272,250/= as direct release to cater for additional medicines towards the various trainings and other operational activities. A supplementary budget of 4,859,628,100/= was released to cater for Anti COVID-19 protective and equipment during the second wave.

8.0 KEY ACHIEVEMENTS

8.1 Quality improvement activities.

- Expanded health services. In the past one year, the Directorate succeeded in upgrading services in the following units.
1. Tororo Police HC III equipped and operationalized maternity services.
 2. Nsambya Palliative care unit was equipped with physiotherapy equipment.
 3. Installation and operationalization of major laboratory equipment (Hematology and Chemistry analyzers) at Nsambya, Masaka and ASTU Katakwi.

8.2 Construction and remodeling

1. With support from Platinum Credit Microfinance, Nsambya Police Health center IV Laboratory was renovated (fencing, construction of patient waiting shade and painting).
2. In addition, a 40 feet long container was fabricated to serve as office space funded by UPF.
3. Directorate of Logistics and Engineering constructed one (01) incinerator at PTS Olilim and four (04) at PTS Kabalye.
4. Using imprest funding, the directorate of PHS renovated nine (09) HCs of Bundibugyo, Kabarole, Mityana, Kiboga, Masaka, Tororo, Pader, Kabale. EMR coordination office and palliative care unit at Nsambya Police HC IV were also renovated.

8.3 Equipment

1. Three (3) Chemistry analyzers were installed and operationalized at Nsambya, Masaka and ASTU Katakwi Police HCs.
2. Two (2) Hematology analyzers were installed and operationalized at Masaka and ASTU Katakwi Police HCs.
3. Physiotherapy machines (Traction table and diathermy machine) were procured for Nsambya palliative care unit.
4. One (1) heavy-duty scientific fridge was procured for PTS Kabalye to support the vaccine cold chain process.
5. Ten (10) Laptops and 10 wireless internet devices (MIFI) were procured to support COVID – 19 vaccination data management.
6. Assorted basic medical equipment and supplies were procured and supplied to different Police health centers.
7. One (1) Computer Desk Top was donated by KCCA– Makindye Division to support HMIS at Nsambya Police HC IV.
8. One (1) Autoclave was donated by USAID to support sterilization services at Nsambya Police HC IV.
9. One (01) coloured printer for printing the COVID 19 vaccination certificates at Nsambya Police HC IV was procured by UPF.

8.4 Human Resource for Health.

- The number of health workers increased from 476 in September 2020 to 505 as of November 2021.
- Promotion of Police health workers; Twenty one (21) Police health workers were promoted to different ranks (PC to IP). Twenty nine (29) Health workers (ranging from PC- SGT) are currently at PTS Kabalye undergoing Officers Basic Course (OBC), which will lead to automatic promotion to the rank of AIP.
- Awards and Honors; Ten (10) Police health workers received the African Union Peace Keeping award/medal upon successful completion of their tour of duty in mission deployments in Somalia and South Sudan.
- Missions and Special deployments; Sixteen (16) health workers benefited

from peace keeping mission deployments abroad. Currently, 06 are under the Formed Police Unit in Somalia. 02 are deployed as IPOs under AU in Somalia and Sudan. 08 are undergoing pre-deployment training in Kikandwa Police training school.

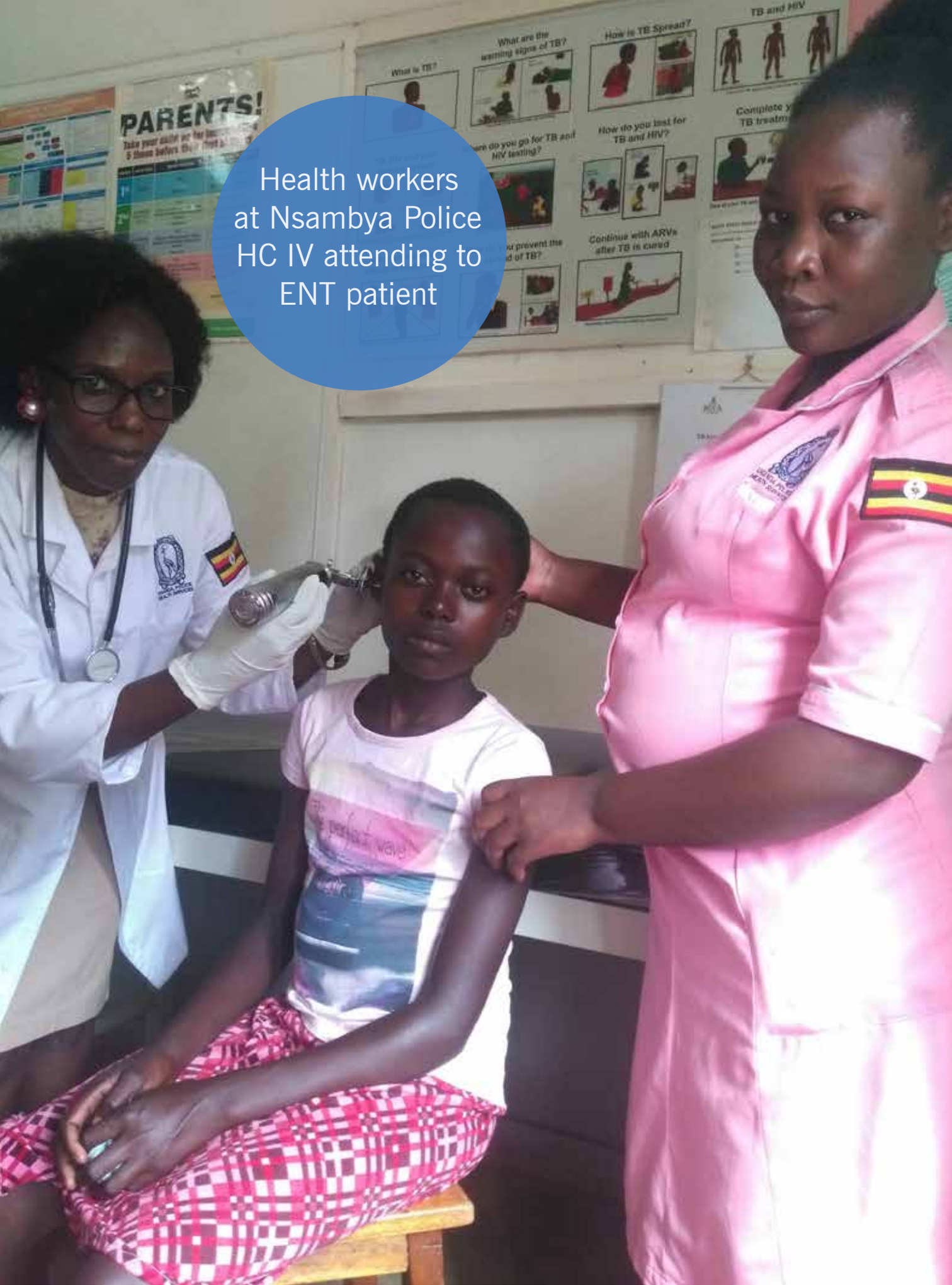
8.6 Imprest for H/C

Police Health centers started receiving imprest in quarter II of FY 2020/2021. HC IV receive 400,000/= and H/C III and II receive 200,000/= which has greatly helped to improve on the working environment and outlook of most health centers. Minor infrastructural repairs in Police health facilities including plumbing, electrical, painting, furniture e.t.c were done using these funds.

9.0 MAJOR CHALLENGES OF 2020/2021

- Lack of a Police referral hospital to reduce on funds spent on treatment of officers who require specialized health care services.
- Inadequate infrastructure characterized by improvised, old and small buildings, inadequacies of diagnostic equipment, transport means, storage facilities, medical waste disposal facilities, and ICT infrastructure.
- Limited capacity to offer all services due to the low level of most of the Police health centers. Out of the 93 Police health centers 79 are health center IIs.
- Understaffing of the critical cadres especially the medical doctors to support the medico-legal services across the country. Only 09 (32%) regions have Police doctors.
- Limited coverage of Police health services across the country. Only 76 of the Policing districts have established Police health centers.
- Inadequate ambulances to cover all Police regions with emergency response & rescue services. UPF has only 26 sound ambulances covering 22 Police regions.(refer to table 9)
- Mismanagement of medical supplies in some HCs. Two (02) Police health workers are in court for theft of drugs while four (04) are being investigated for alleged theft of drugs.

10.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

- Establish a Police referral hospital to reduce individual and institutional expenses spent on the management of referred cases.
- Recruit more health workers in required numbers & professional diversity to fill the existing staffing gaps.
- Renovate & remodel existing Police health facilities to match the required MOH structural standards.
- Upgrade Police HC IIs to level III and HC IIIs to level IV in order to handle the high demand of health services in UPF.
- Adequately equip Police health services to deal with prevailing logistical challenges (i.e. with diagnostic equipment, medicines/health supplies, storage facilities & ambulances).
- Gradually increase the number of Police health centers to cover all Police regions, districts /divisions and specialized units.
- Support training of Police health workers to attain advanced technical and management qualifications.
- Promote qualified and competent officers to fill the existing management gaps.
- Increase funding for sustainable health supplies and implementation of all critical health activities.
- Expand ICT infrastructure to enable electronic data management (DHIS2) by all police health centers.

11.0 BEST PRACTICES AND INNOVATIONS

1. Regular Health Management Committee meetings are an important platform for decision making and the follow up of the resolutions can easily be done.
2. Full time availability of free UPF Emergency Medical Response service to support UPF & national emergency operations added value and improved the image of Police in Public.
3. PHS has attracted more members of the community seeking healthcare services due to availability of qualified Police health workers with good customer care.
4. Provision of healthcare services to the underserved and hard to reach areas through outreaches and mobile clinics.
5. Stakeholder collaboration & networking aimed at provision of quality healthcare to the Police community. This includes MoH, development partners, local governments & the community.
6. The AGM that brings together representation from all Police health facilities to discuss pertinent issues aimed at improving health service delivery in UPF.
7. Office imprest allocated to the directorate has been strictly used for the improvement of working environment in the Police health centers.
8. The formulation and implementation of the first health policy in UPF.
9. The directorate implemented TB prevention and control activity in KMP Police cells through identification of coughers, sputum samples collection, transportation, testing and management of TB positive suspects. In the reporting period, 17 Police stations (Katwe, Old Kampala, Kabalagala, Wandegeya, Jinja road, Kira road, CPS Kampala, Kawempe and Nsambya) were involved in the activity.
