MUSA GALIWANGO, MOST WANTED SUSPECT FINALLY ARRESTED

Today April 17, 2018, at around 2:30 am, the Uganda Police Force working hand in hand with good and responsible citizens were able to track and arrest the suspect, one Musa Galiwango who recently escaped from court while he was answering to the numerous charges of murder, aggravated robbery and terrorism together with his accomplice, Muhammad Kiddawalime who was recently killed by an irate mob having gone to attack another home in Bukulula, Kalungu District.

It will be recalled that the duo are widely believed to have master minded the murders in Greater Masaka where on New Year's Eve, 1st, January 2018, they participated in the murder of five (5) people in Bukomansimbi District, including a senior police officer, SSP Ssebugwawo Lumala who had just retired.

The Uganda Police Force intensified the hunt for Musa Galiwango and today at 2:30am, he was arrested. He was violent and held his pistol, wanting to shoot the arresting officers. He was shot at in the process as he too attempted to shoot the officers that were arresting him.

Finally, the most wanted suspect, Musa Galiwango was arrested in KIGARAMA village, KAJARA County, NTUNGAMO District. He was arrested and a star pistol was recovered. The weapon star pistol is unmarked and the magazine was found to be empty.

Currently, he is undergoing treatment at Mbarara referral hospital. He is heavily guarded to avoid another incident of escape as he did while in court.

We want to thank the security teams and the community that worked to enable us arrest this notorious suspect implicated in numerous murders and armed robberies in the Greater Masaka area.

The Uganda Police Force hereby assures the public that we shall ensure that justice is done and we shall continue to protect all Ugandans especially those feeling intimidated by criminal elements in their localities. It's our duty to protect and serve.
