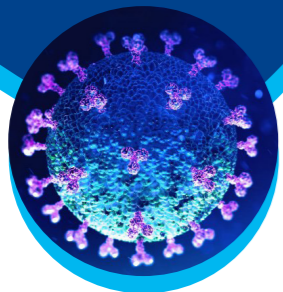

5. Be your neighbor's keeper by ensuring that you report any suspected cases of persons with COVID-19.
